




How to prepare your apartment for anti-cockroach treatment

Before the exterminator comes, please follow these instructions to prepare your apartment.


IMPORTANT: If you do not follow the instructions to prepare your apartment, the exterminator will not be able to do the treatment.

Make room. The exterminator needs to move around easily to do the treatment.



Prepare your kitchen



Empty drawers and cabinets.



Leave on the table 1 plate, 1 cup, 1 glass, 1 fork, 1 knife, 1 spoon, 1 or 2 pans to prepare your hot meals.



Place all your other dishes in plastic bags or plastic containers.






Store dry food in airtight containers.



Put fruits and vegetables in the refrigerator.




Put potatoes, onions and garlic in the refrigerator.



Put all the food in the cupboard in plastic bags or plastic containers.



Do not use cardboard boxes.



Wash the entire kitchen with hot water and dish soap



Remove all greasy residue, dust, water, food and bread crumbs.



Wash the interior and exterior of cabinets and drawers.



Wash the top of the refrigerator.



Wash the walls.




Wash the range hood and hood filter.



Wash the inside and outside of the oven.



Wash all counters.



Wash behind all appliances.



Wash the floor.



Empty your garbage cans often.



Throw out your garbage in small plastic bags. Close the bags securely.



Dispose of the bag in the designated garbage chute or bin.



Put your items to be recycled in the recycling bins.






Prepare the bathroom



Empty the cabinet under the sink. Clear everything off of the counter around the sink. Put everything in plastic bags or plastic containers.



Wash the bathroom with hot water and dish soap.



Wash the floor with hot water and dish soap.



Do not use vinegar, bleach and insecticides.



Your home is now ready for the treatment.
