

# **Locking the entrance** to your building

We are beginning the project of keeping your building locked at all times. Right now, the entrance is unlocked between 8 a.m. and 10 p.m. and locked between 10 p.m. and 8 a.m. When the project is complete, the entrance will be locked at all times. You will need to use your key fob to enter your building.





### How the project will work in your building

August 24, 2022	1. Here you can read all the information from the meeting.
August 25 to September 9, 2022	<ol> <li>Check to see how many key fobs you have for your family. The key fobs you have will still work. People who are named on the lease and aged 12 and older can have a key fob.</li> <li>Please contact the call centre at 514-872-6646 to replace a lost key fob or to order new key fobs. If you lose your key fob and need a new one, or to order extra key fobs, it costs \$25.00.</li> </ol>
Mid-September 2022	4. The new key fobs will be programmed.
Late September	<ul> <li>5. You can pick up the key fobs on-site. There will be a notice showing the date and opening hours for the ground-floor office at 1830 Duff Court.</li> <li>6. Payment options for key fobs: <ul> <li>cheque;</li> <li>direct debit to your account, if you are already enrolled in this service;</li> <li>cash, in the office at 2247 Delisle Street, 3rd floor, between 8:30 a.m. and 12 p.m. or between 1 p.m. and 4:30 p.m., after the key fobs have been distributed.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
After the key fobs have been distributed	7. Use your key fob to enter your building. The entrance will be locked at all times.

## **Basement and garage access**

Between 7 a.m. and 10 p.m., you can use your key fob in the elevator to go to the basement, for your storage space or the recycling room. People with reduced mobility can still use the access ramp and the garage.

### **reason** for this work

The aim of this project is to make Place Lachine safer. Keeping the buildings locked 24 hours a day is one of the things we want to try.

Safety is everyone's responsibility. Let's work together to make your community safer. Together, we can do it!

We ask you to please follow these important instructions:

- Use the intercom to ask visitors who they are before letting them inside your building.
- Avoid lending your key fob to anyone. You are responsible for keeping it safe.
- Please avoid spending extra time in the stairs. It's important to keep the stairs clear because they are emergency exits.
