We finished relocating all Habitations Charlevoix residents in August.


We have awarded the contract to a contractor.


The work has begun.

# Work in progress

Here is the major upcoming work for the site:

- 1. We will strengthen the structure of the building (fall 2022 to winter 2023)
- 2. We will carry out the following work on all facades, one facade or section at a time (fall 2022 to fall 2023):
  - remove brick, doors and windows
  - add insulation
  - install new doors and windows
  - lay brick

We will also carry out the following work:

- 3. Replace the roof (fall 2022 to spring/summer 2023)
- 4. Improve ventilation and perform electrical and plumbing work (fall 2022 to summer 2023)
- 5. Repair balconies and replace balcony railings and dividers (spring and summer 2023)
- 6. Renovate the entrances and ramp (fall 2023)
- 7. Carry out work in apartments (fall 2023 to spring 2024)
- 8. Redo the outer courtyard and landscaping (spring and summer 2024)



Throughout the relocation process, your liaison officer was there to:

- provide support
- assess your needs and connect you with neighbourhood resources
- answer your questions or direct you to someone who could, when necessary
- provide information about the next steps
- support some residents as they prepared for the move

 provide information about your future neighbourhood, the tenant association, the community organizer and community organizations

Your outreach worker was on site 1 to 3 times every week. We also organized workshops and activities.

Your pest control response officer:

- followed up on all treatments prior to the move
- made sure to limit the spread of vermin during moves
- planned the necessary preventive treatments in your new apartment
- will continue to follow up with you as needed

We will continue to provide updates as the work progresses.

## Relocation

The building needs some major improvement work, so we had to relocate all residents until the renovations are complete.

#### We have:

- found low-rent housing units for 56 residents
- organized 56 moves
- delivered nearly 2,000 boxes to help residents prepare
- helped around 10 tenants prepare their boxes

We did our best to accommodate everyone's needs.


We worked with the Clinique communautaire de Pointe-Saint-Charles to:

- identify residents with medical needs or who are receiving home support from the clinic
- ensure that these residents continue to receive the services they need
- ensure that the new apartments are adapted to their needs

We will also provide support to help you move back.
