Beginning of work in your building

We need to do work to:



- Add insulation to exterior walls.
- 2 Replace brick on front and rear facades.
- 3 Replace the doors and windows in all apartments and common areas.
- 4 Replace balconies and railings.
- **6** Replace the stairs of the exterior exits at the back of the building.
- 6 Replace bathroom fans in all apartments.
- **2** Replace some equipment in the electrical room in the basement.
- 8 Redo the parking lot.
- 9 Redevelop the land after the work is completed.

In some apartments, we will also:

- Replace the range hood.
- 1 Replace or add smoke alarms.
- 2 Replace the electrical panel.

Work in apartments will start at 8 a.m.

• Attend the information meeting on September 11 at 4 p.m. The meeting will be held in the backyard of your building. We will be there with the contractor to talk about the work.

There was a **consultation meeting** involving the 6 tenants on July 5, 2022. You said that you would like to:

- Have gardening containers;
- Keep the planting spaces on both sides of the yard;
- Have the tree in the backyard trimmed;
- Have more low lighting in the yard;
- Have the backyard flower bed relandscaped.

You do not want the plantings too high at the front of the building.

We will do our best to meet your requests in accordance with the project's budgets.

What you need to do

- 1. When the contractor asks, you must:
 - Clear everything off your balcony. Read the instructions included with this document.
 - Remove everything within one metre (3 feet) of doors and windows. Read the instructions included with this document.
- 2. Look for a notice on your apartment door.
 - The date and time of the work in your apartment will be posted on your door.
 - You will be notified at least 2 days in advance.
 - The work will take place will between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m.
 - Be home on the day of the work or ask someone you trust to be there. If no one is available, please inform your liaison officer as soon as possible.

What you need to do (next)	 3. Contact your liaison officer if: You have a satellite dish on your balcony. The satellite dish must be removed before work can be done on the balconies. You have a parking space. You will need to park on the street during the parking lot work. We can find a solution regarding this.
Inconveniences during the work	 There will be noise, dust and machines. At certain times: You will not have access to your balconies and the parking lot. There will be power interruptions during electrical work. Please read all information notices.
Reasons for this work	Some parts of the building have reached the end of their useful life. Work is needed to better protect the building against leakages. The work will prevent air and water from entering your building. Your comfort and quality of life will be improved.

When the contractor asks, you must:

- Remove everything within one metre (3 feet) of doors.



Your windows



When the contractor asks, you must:

- Remove everything within at least one metre (3 feet) of windows.
- Remove air conditioners from windows before work begins in your apartment.



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
