

- To meet standards for air conditioning and ventilation.

Reasons for this work

There is no recycling in your building. The borough will soon begin collecting compost, so we will put brown compost bins in the new garbage room.

After the work

A team will meet you to answer your questions about recycling and compost. You will receive a small bin to transport your composting waste from your apartment to the new garbage room.
