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Get involved

What you need **to do**

1. Appointment Notice

- Look for notices posted on your apartment door at least **2 days before the work is scheduled to start**.
- It will provide the time and date **of the work to be done in your apartment**.
- **The work will be carried out between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m.**
- **Duration: 1–2 days per apartment.**
- **You may remain in your apartment during the work.**

2. Before the work

When you know your scheduled date:

- **Remove all items within 1 metre (3 feet) of doors and windows.**
- **Clear off your balcony completely** (follow the instructions included with this document).
- **Remove any obstacles that could obstruct the workers' access.**
- **Workers will need to enter your living room and bedrooms.**

3. Presence is mandatory

- Please make sure to be **at home on the day of the work**.
- If you can't be there, ask someone you trust (neighbour, friend, family) to stand in for you.

4. In case of absence

- **If no one can be there**, notify the workers or your community organizer as soon as possible.

5. Safety

- **Stay away from the site and equipment.**
- **Please respect the safety perimeter.**



inconveniences during the work

- Parking will not be accessible. Affected tenants will be contacted.
- You will not have access to the balcony during the work.
- There will be noise and dust.
- Pets must be kept in a cage/crate or in another room (the common room will be available if needed).
- There will be workers and equipment on site from 7 a.m.

Why carry out the work?

- This work is necessary because we need to replace the doors and windows that are outdated.
- The new equipment will keep water and air out of your apartment.
- This will reduce the risk of mould.

Investments : \$2,5M

Important informations

- The laundry room is now available.
- Please do not use the laundry room at 4450, rue Saint-Jacques.
- Your key will be collected later.
