



#### **Doors and windows colors**

- Interior finish: White
- Exterior finish: Commercial brown





### Sequence of work in the apartments

- Work will proceed one block at a time.
- Work will begin on the units in Block 1 (near George Street).
- Block 2 will follow, and work will end with Block 3.
- Work will proceed from top to bottom;
  4th floor to 1st floor.






#### 1. Look for a notice on your apartment door.

- The **date and time** of the work in your apartment will be indicated on this notice.
- This notice will be posted on your door at least 2 days in advance.
- The work will be carried out between 8 a.m. and5 p.m.
- Duration of work per apartment: 1 to 2 days (you can stay in your apartment during the work).

#### 2. When you have your scheduled appointment::

- remove anything within 1 metre (3 feet) in front of doors and windows (see the attached instructions).
- remove all items from your balcony (see the attached instructions).
- move anything in your apartment that could get in the workers' way. They will need to work in your living room and bedrooms.
- 3. Please **be home on the day of the work.** If you cannot be there, ask **someone you trust to be there**. This could be a neighbour, friend, or family member.
- 4. If you cannot be at home and neither can anyone else, please tell the workers or your liaison officer as soon as possible.
- 5. Keep a distance from the site and equipment to avoid an accident.
- 6. Respect the safety perimeter.

- You will not have access to your balcony while we replace your apartment's door and windows.
- Pets must be kept in a cage or in another room (the common room is available if needed).
- There may be noise and dust.
- There will be workers and machinery from 7 a.m.

**Reasons** for this work

This work is required because the doors and windows are at the end of their useful life.

The new doors and windows will be more waterproof. They will no longer let water and air in. This will reduce the risk of mould.

When the contractor asks, you must:

- Remove everything within one metre (3 feet) of doors.











## **Your windows**







When the contractor asks, you must:

- Remove everything within at least one metre (3 feet) of windows.
- Remove air conditioners from windows before work begins in your apartment.

# Your balcony



When the contractor asks, you must:

- Clear everything off your balcony, including bicycles, flower pots and furniture.
