Major work

We will soon begin work on the buildings located at 2055, 2075 2095, 2115, 2135, 2155, Rue Notre-Dame Ouest.

If you do not live at one of the above addresses, you receive this document for **information only**.



We will do the following work:

- 1 Demolish exterior concrete stairs, sidewalks and asphalt garage entrance.
- 2 Replace balcony floors and railings.
- 3 Replace awnings.
- 4 Clean bathroom ventilation ducts.
- **5** Replace range hoods.
- 6 Install new doors and windows.
- 7 Redo backyard landscaping.

The following work will only be done in the six vacant apartments:

- Completely renovate bathrooms, if needed.
- Replace rear stairs if needed.
- Replace plumbing components (basin, toilet, etc.), if needed.
- Replace electrical fixtures (switches, outlets, etc.), if needed.
- Strip floor and wax.
- Paint apartments.



Work dates:

- Vacant apartments: October 2022 to February 2023
- Garage doors, stairs and range hoods: October to November 2022
- Balconies, brick walls and backyard: Spring to Summer 2023
- New entrance and balcony's doors, and windows: Summer 2023
- → Check for notices to know the exact dates of work.









- 1. Unless it is an emergency, please contact the liaison officer. Please do not talk to the workers.
- 2. When workers come to clean the ventilation ducts and install the range hood:

Remove all items from the top of the oven.

Clear the nearby kitchen counters.



Clear the bathroom counter.



- 3. When workers replace the **doors and windows**, please follow the **instructions** provided with this document.
- 4. You will need to clear your balcony. Please follow the instructions provided with this document.
- 5. **Check for any notices at the building entrance.** For example, there will be a notice if the power is to be turned off.
- 6. **Check for any notices on your apartment door.** The time and date of the work in your apartment will be posted on your door.
 - You will be notified at least two days in advance. The work will take place between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m.
- 7. Please be home on the day of the work. If you cannot be home, ask someone you trust to be there instead, such as a neighbour, friend or family member.
- 8. If you cannot be home and no one can be there for you, inform your liaison officer as soon as possible.



- Noise, dust and the presence of machinery.
- Workers will need to enter your apartment to clean the ventilation ducts, install the range hood and the doors and windows.
- You will not be able to use the garage entrance when the workers replace the asphalt. Check for notices for the exact dates of work.
- You will not be able to use the main entrances when the workers are redoing the sidewalks. You will need to use a different entrance.
- For your safety, you will not have access to your balcony during some work. Check for notices for the exact dates.

- Clear everything off your balcony, including bicycles, flower pots and furniture.











PREPARING FOR ON-SITE WORK

Your doors

When the contractor asks, you must:

- Remove everything within one metre (3 feet) of doors.











Your windows







When the contractor asks, you must:

- Remove everything within at least one metre (3 feet) of windows.
- Remove air conditioners from windows before work begins in your apartment.
