## Electrical work in apartments begins

The electrical work started in January continues.

We will begin the scheduled work in apartments around mi-August 2023.

### Scheduled work in your apartment

1. We will replace the fuse box. The fuse box may be moved elsewhere in the apartment.
2. Once we have replaced the fuse box, we will repair the wall (drywalling, plastering and painting) before the end of Octobre 2023.



Get involved

what you need to do

1. Participate at the **information meeting** on **Thursday, August 3, 2023 at 4 p.m.** in the common room.
2. **Look for a notice on your apartment door.**

The notice will tell you the date and time of work to be done in your apartment.

We will notify you **at least 2 days in advance.**

Workers will come between **8 a.m. and 5 p.m.**





Get involved

What you need to do  
(next)

- Please be at **home on the day work is to be done in your apartment**. If you cannot be there, **ask someone you trust** to be there.
  - You could ask a **neighbour, friend, or family member**.
  - If you **cannot be at home and neither can anyone else**, please tell **the workers** or your **liaison officer** as soon as possible.
2. **When the workers come to replace the fuse box:**
- Make room in your apartment.** Workers must be able to move through easily.
- Remove objects near the fuse box** located at one of the following locations:
- near the stove
  - in a closet
  - in the hall
3. **Plan** ahead for **power cuts**. For example:
- Relax in the common room.
  - Plan activities to pass the time (visit a friend, ...).
  - Plan your meals, if necessary.



**Schedule:**

Mid-January  
to the end of October 2023

**Work in the apartments:**

mid-August  
to the end of October 2023



**Hours:**

Monday to Friday,  
from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

## inconveniences during the work

- There will be some noise, but it should not disturb you very much.
- There will be workers in your apartment and in the building.
- There will be no power when:
  - We replace fuse boxes in the apartments

**Power may be off for 2 to 3 hours.** Teams will be working in different apartments at the same time to reduce the inconvenience.

There may be no power in your apartment even if there is no work in your apartment. We will combine work periods to limit power cuts.

## reason for this work

Replacing the fuse boxes:

- Improves safety
- Reduces the risk of fuse box malfunction
- Increases power supply for modern appliances
